



SAILING CAMP AMBASSADORS NEEDED

Queen City Junior Yacht Club needs adult volunteers mornings and afternoons Monday-Friday when sailing camp is in session to serve as Junior Sailing Ambassadors to the QCJYC Junior Sailing Program. Volunteers should be QCYC members who would enjoy interacting with camp counselors, campers (ages 8-14), and caregivers. The primary purpose is to facilitate a safe and fun experience for QCJYC campers and serve as a point of escalation to the camp counselors.

Morning Volunteer (8:30 to 9:30 am)

Support counselors as they greet campers and their caregivers upon arrival. If needed, give directional assistance to the 3rd floor Captain's Room, where campers will meet up with counselors, location of restrooms, and where campers can be picked up in the afternoon. Since a new camp session starts each week, it is especially important to have a morning volunteer on Mondays.

Afternoon Volunteer (3:30 to 4:30 pm)

Support counselors as they return from sailing on Dock 3. Provide general oversight as counselors and campers stow life jackets and gear. At the end of the day the Captain's room and Dock 3 are to be left tidy and ready for the next day of camp. Counselors may also need help reminding campers to be safe while on docks.

On-Call Chase Boat Volunteer

Also looking for volunteers with a dinghy moored at the club that can be called to assist camp counselors as needed. Preferably this is someone on a live-aboard, or who live/works near the club, in order to assist on short notice.
