## REVISED RULES AND PROCEDURES OF THE TARETTES ADOPTED BY THE BOARD, JANUARY 3, 2018

- 1. The immediate past president shall be an advisor on the board.
- 2. The Women's Interclub Council representative shall be in charge of the WIC luncheon at QCYC.
- 3. The dress code for the Tarettes Officers at Tarettes meetings between May 1 September 30 shall be a red jacket/blazer, white top/blouse, and white slacks/skirt. From October 1 April 30 the dress will be red jacket/blazer, white top/blouse, and navy blue slacks/skirt.
- 4. It is recommended that Tarettes members wear dress as specified by the president to WIC luncheons and when serving at Memorials and Opening Day committees.
- 5. The installation procedure shall proceed as outlined in the President's Manual. All outgoing and incoming officers shall dress in uniform.
- 6. Outgoing officers and committee chairpersons shall be recognized at the Decommissioning Ceremony at the Annual Meeting.
- 7. Active members who leave Queen City Yacht Club may petition the Tarettes' Board for continued Tarettes member status. The board may grant such status if the petitioner has regularly participated in Tarettes' events and intends to remain active. Such special membership status needs to reviewed periodically and may be revoked by the board. Tarettes who are not members of QCYC are limited to use of club facilities in conjunction with Tarettes activities and guest privileges.
